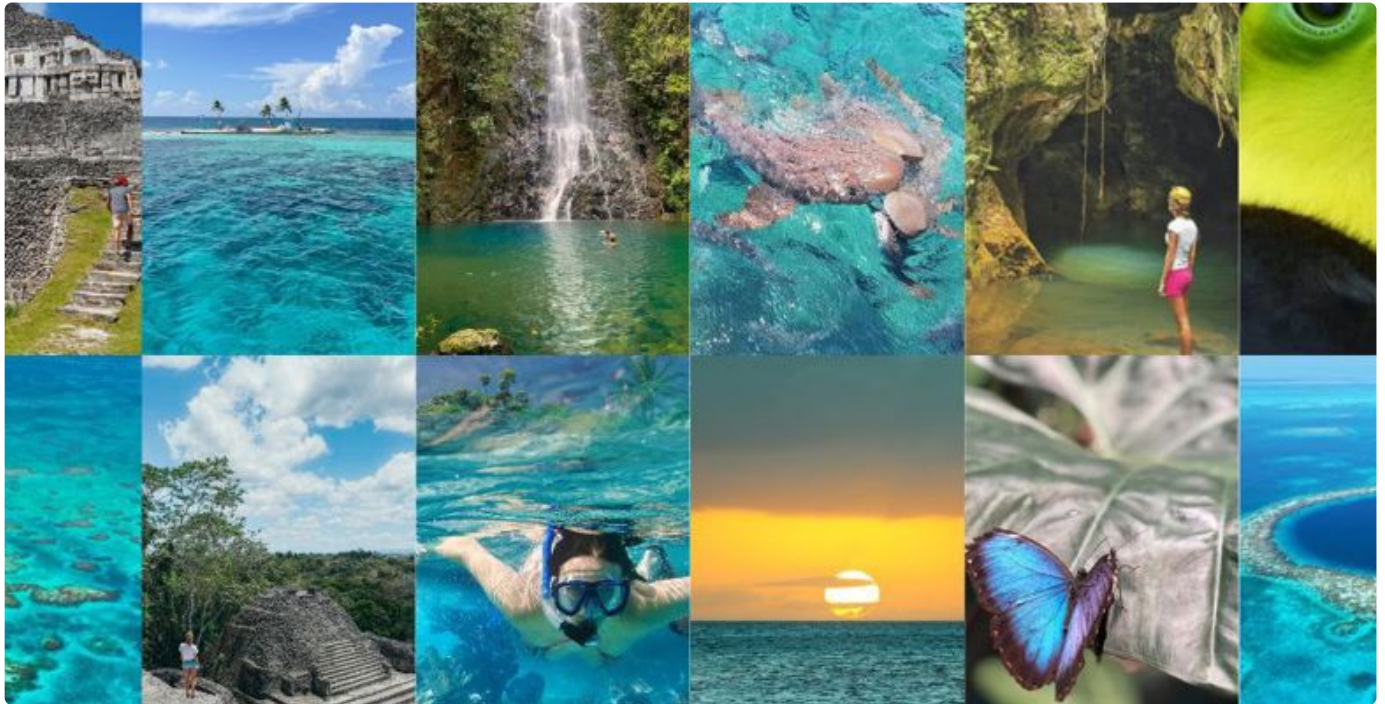

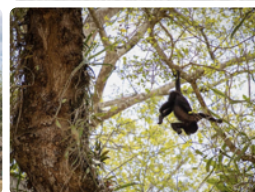
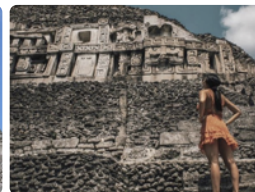

The scenic tour encompasses views of the barrier reef, shark ray alley, Turneffe Atoll, ocean freighter wreck, lighthouse reef and 2 revolutions per port and starboard around the Blue Hole.
